It's a long and dangerous trip, but one that's been faced by some 584 personnel (402 from the RFS) in 155 vehicles (79 from RFS) since the deployment began. Bob and Tim and our Cat 7



have now become part of the largest interstate operation ever undertaken by the NSW Rural Fire Service. Other Tuross Head Brigade members are on standby

and this quiet departure is expected to be replicated a number of times in the near future.



The current report from Victoria is that “the weather situation remains OK with cooler temperatures and showers across Melbourne this morning. Friday, however remains a day of concern with strategies being developed to deal with the anticipated extension of fire edge”. Our thoughts and prayers

continue to be with all those who have been, and continue to be, severely affected by these horrific fires.
